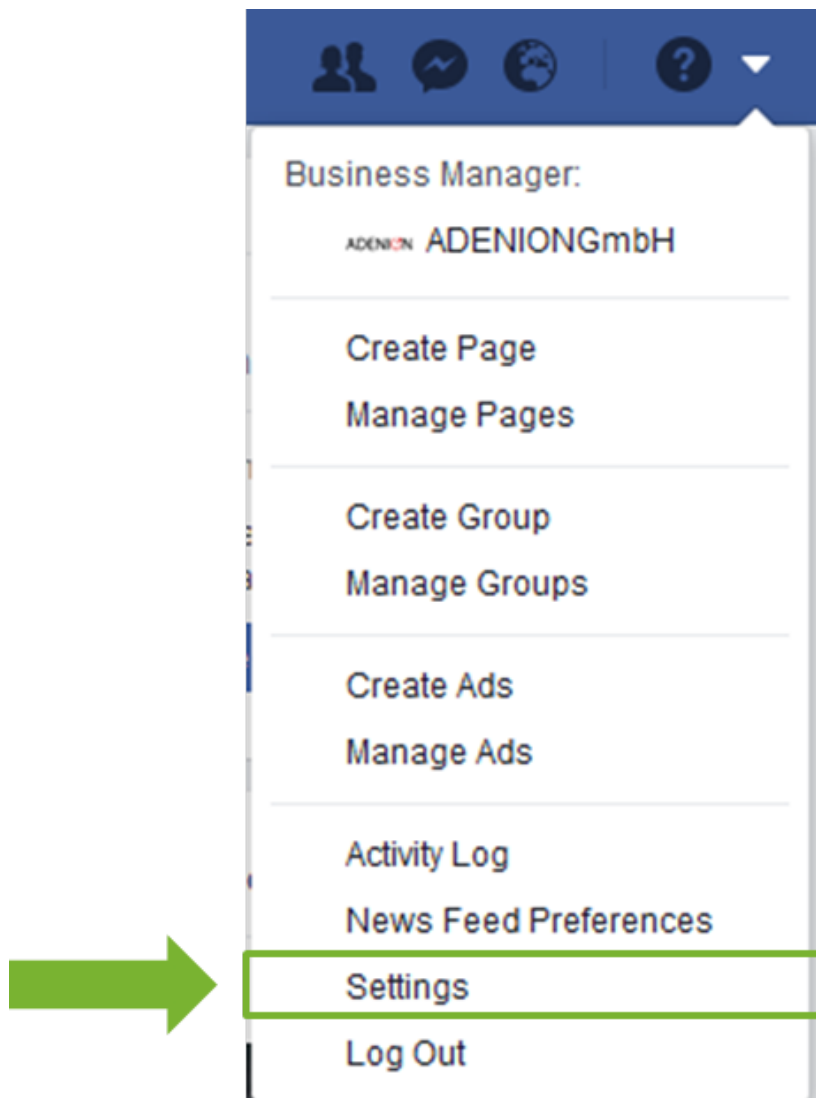


Helpful Network Settings


How can I change the visibility settings of my Facebook posts?


