


Customizing Social Media Posts

How do I insert the full-length text of my post?


For some networks, such as Facebook and Flickr, Blog2Social gives you the option to insert the full-text of your Wordpress post as a comment to your Social Media post.

You can do so within the one-page-editor preview of your Social Media posts.

1. To insert full-text click the underlined "Insert full-text"
2. To delete full-text click the underlined "Delete full-text"
